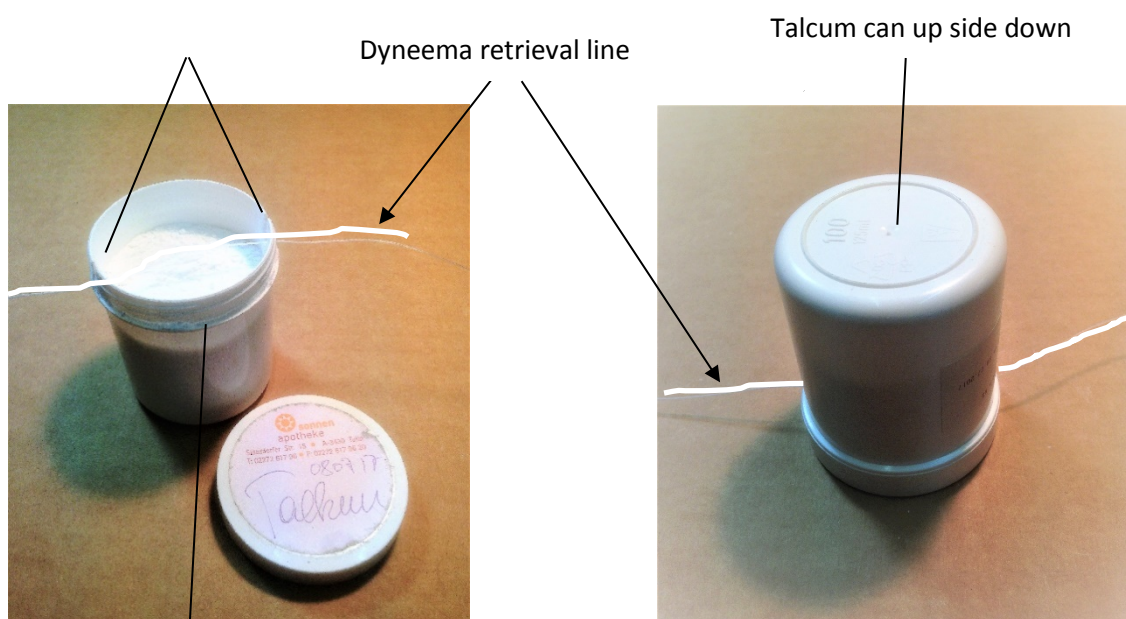
Talcum (talc, baby powder) makes retrieval line slippery again

After some time, the Dyneema-retrieval line might cause some unwanted drag in the bowden guide line. By applying talcum (baby powder) this drag can be reduced again.

How to apply talc on the retrieval line:

- To make 2 slots into the talcum can, drill two opposite, 1.5mm wide holes in the threaded portion of the can and then scissor them from the edge to the drilled holes.
- Move bug wiper out from the fuselage by half a meter
- Set retrieval line into slots as shown in the left picture down below.
- Screw the cap onto the can, but only so far that the line can still be easily pulled through the slots.
- Turn the can upside down.
- Now, ask somebody to pull the bug wiper out to the wing tip. By holding the talcum can upside down and pulling the retrieval line through the slots, the talcum powder will be applied to the line.
- Repeat several times, if necessary
- Then turn the can over, unscrew the cap and release the retrieval line.
- After that pull bug wiper back into the stand by position at the fuselage
